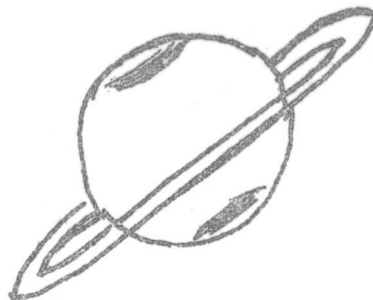

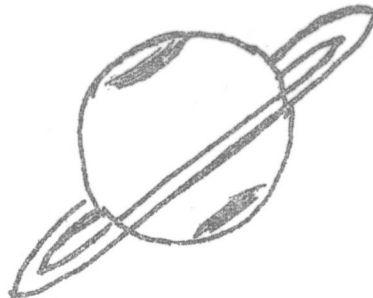

The President Reports.

When observing deep sky objects, do we sometimes overlook the obvious in search for something new? Do we fail to see the forest because the trees are in the way? These old sayings have quite a bit of truth in them.

On sat, sept 10th, Rick Johnson, Monte, Steve, were out at my place.

We had done quite a bit of observing in the southern milky way. We found a lot of Globulars and Clusters in Sagittarius. M31 was getting fairly high and out of the haze. A close look at it revealed some dark lanes. They ran parallel to the length of the galaxy. Just below the nucleus, about one third of the way ---- toward M-32.

About one thirty, Rick loaded his telescope in the car and I was ready to put mine away. I looked up and M31 was directly overhead. I put in the 10mm eyepiece which is about 63X on my 8 inch scope. After getting the nucleus of the Galaxy centered, I then moved to the left, then to the right of center. Sure enough I could see the dark lanes going nearly all the way around the Galaxy. So with a little time and patience, and an excellent Sky Condition, New and inspiring thrills can be had with M31 even the oldest and most common of the deep sky objects.
